ABOUT THE ANNUAL BIPARTISAN CONGRESSIONAL AWARDS

Since 1992, the Annual Bipartisan Congressional Awards event has become widely recognized as Washington DC's signature social event following Congress' return from its traditional August recess. As one Capitol Hill regular put it, "This is like Back to School Night for Washington's health policy community – you see everyone here."

The Annual Bipartisan Congressional Awards event also has a deeper purpose: to remind lawmakers of the nation's bipartisan commitment to advance medical research to improve the lives of millions of older Americans.
