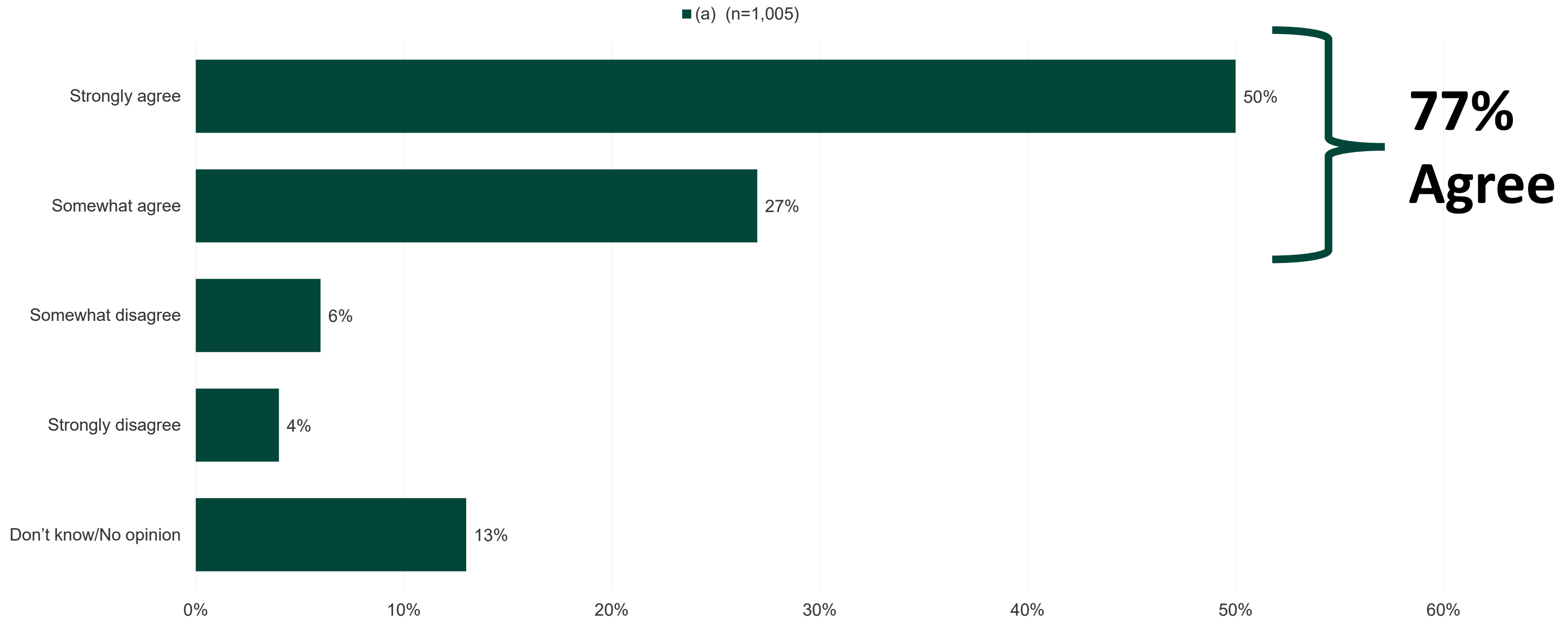
**CARAVAN**<sup>®</sup>

This CARAVAN survey was conducted by Big Village among a sample of 1,005 adults 18 years of age and older. The online omnibus study is conducted three times a week among a demographically representative U.S. sample of 1,000 adults 18 years of age and older. This survey was live on May 15-17, 2026.

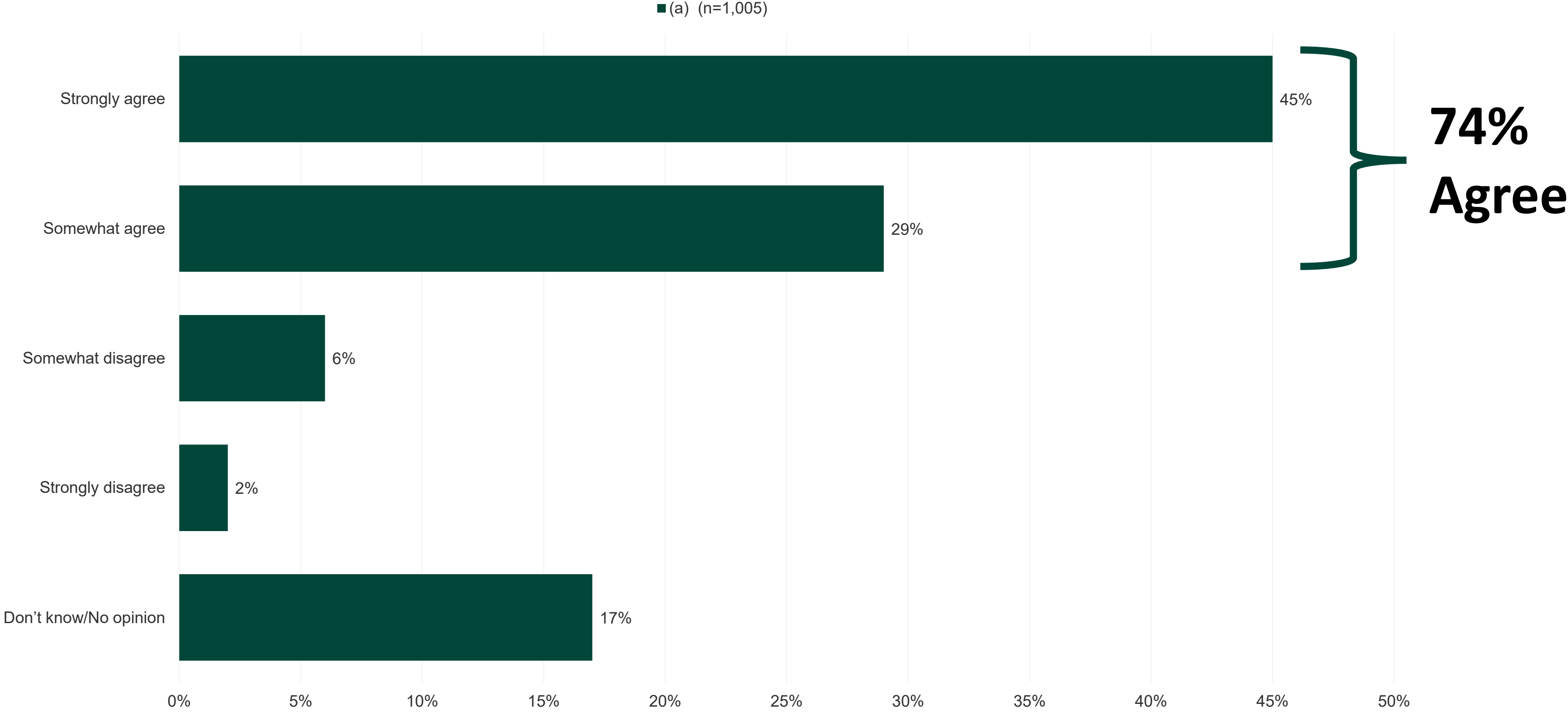
**TAVR SURVEY (05/15/2026 – 05/17/2026)**

Aortic stenosis is a common type of heart valve disease, impacting around 2.5 million seniors over the age of 75. For those with SEVERE aortic stenosis, there are two main treatments. One option is open-heart surgery. The other option is TAVR—a less-invasive procedure with a shorter hospital stay and recovery time—that was approved by the FDA 15 years ago and is the recommended treatment for many patients.

T1. Currently, Medicare restricts patient access to TAVR. How much do you agree or disagree that Medicare should cover TAVR the same way it covers open-heart surgery?

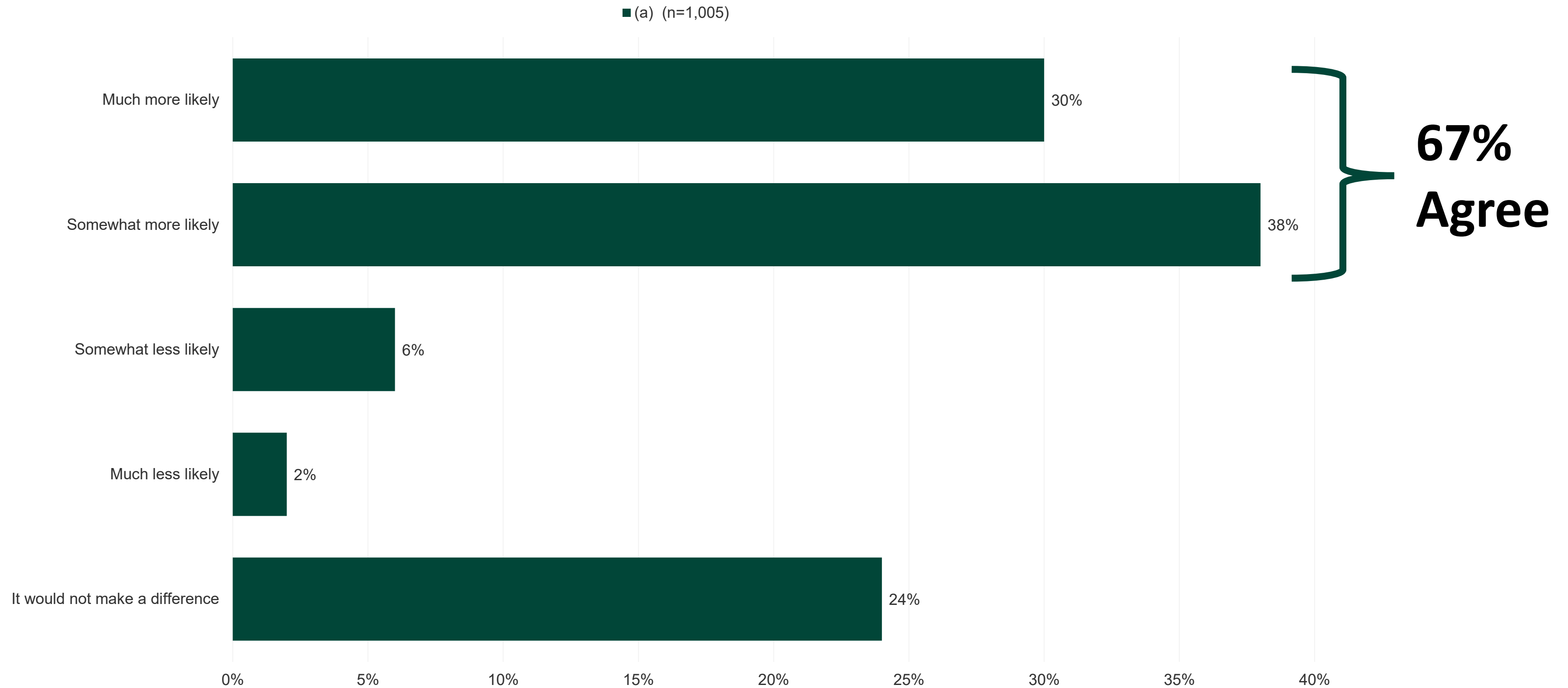
